

**Public Path (Diversion) Order
Town and Country Planning Act 1990, Section 257
Wildlife and Countryside Act 1981, Section 53A**

**Staffordshire County Council
Diversion of Public Footpaths
No. 5 Hednesford Parish**

This Order is made by Staffordshire County Council under Section 257 of the Town and Country Planning Act 1990, because it is satisfied that it is necessary to divert the footpaths to which this order relates in order to enable development to be carried out in accordance with planning permission granted under Part III of the Town and Country Planning Act 1990 namely; to facilitate the housing development off Green Heath Road, Hednesford, Cannock.

This Order is also made under Section 53A(2) of the Wildlife & Countryside Act 1981 ("the 1981 Act") because it appears to the authority that the Definitive Map and Statement for the District of Cannock Chase require modification in consequence of the occurrence of an event specified in Section 53A(a)(i) of the 1981 Act, namely the diversion (as authorised by this Order) of a highway shown or required to be shown in the Map and Statement.

BY THIS ORDER:

1. The public rights of way over the land at Hednesford in Cannock Chase District, shown by a bold continuous grey line on the attached map and described in part 1 of the Schedule to this Order after 28 days from the date of confirmation of this Order, and thereupon the Definitive Map for the District of Cannock Chase shall be modified by deleting from it those public rights of way.

2. There shall, at the end of 28 days from the date of confirmation of this Order, be public footpaths over the land situate at Hednesford in the District of Cannock Chase as provided in Part 2 of the Schedule and shown by bold black broken lines on the attached map and thereupon the Definitive Map for the District of Cannock Chase shall be modified by adding those paths to it.

3. The diversion of the footpaths shall have effect on the confirmation of this Order.

4. Where immediately before the date on which a footpath is diverted there is apparatus under, in, on, along or across it belonging to statutory undertakers for the purpose of carrying on their undertaking, the undertakers shall continue to have the same rights in respect of the apparatus as they then had.

Description Existing Paths

That length of Public Footpath No.5 Hednesford Parish commencing at a point on Green Heath Road 399376 313403 (point A on the order plan) in a

generally southwesterly direction for approximately 385 metres to the southern end of the link footway from Pye Green Road to the rear of 35 Chalcot Drive 399095 313174 (point C on the order plan)

Part II

Description of New Paths

A new length of Public Footpath No.5 Hednesford Parish commencing at a point opposite No. 310 Green Heath Road 399378 313391 (point B on the order plan) and running in a generally west southwesterly direction for approximately 59 metres to 399322 313369 (point D on the order plan) then in a generally southerly direction for approximately 25 metres to 399328 313345 (point E on the order plan) then in a generally west southwesterly direction turning south southwest for approximately 57 metres to 399292 313305 (point F on the order plan) then in a westerly direction for approximately 42 metres to 399249 313304 (point G on the order plan) then in a northerly direction for 8 metres to 399245 313310 (point H on the order plan) then in a generally westerly direction for approximately 6 metres to 399239 313309 (point J on the order plan) then in a southerly direction for 4 metres to 399240 313305 (point K on the order plan) then in a west southwesterly direction for approximately 88 metres to 399153 313290 (point L on the order plan) then in a generally south southwesterly direction for approximately 130 metres to 399095 313174 at the southern end of the link footway from Pye Green Road to the rear of 35 Chalcot Drive (point C on the order plan) to re-join with the remaining part of Public Footpath No. 5 Hednesford Parish.

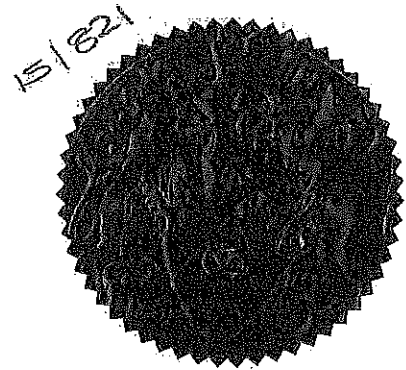
The new route shall have a prescribed width of 2 metres.

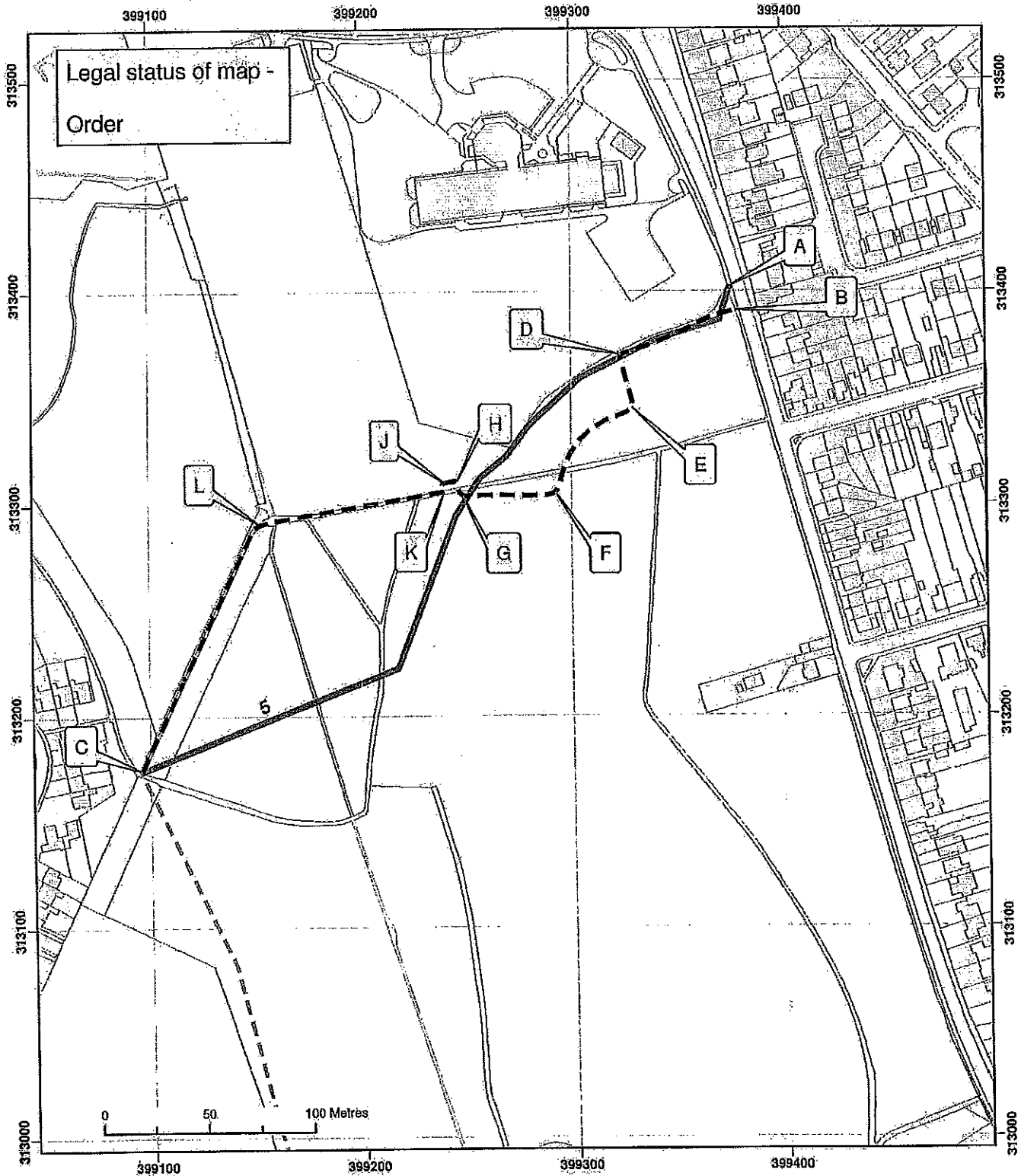
